School Liaison

- Kindergarten Transition Workshops: Scheduled for Tuesday, 23 Jan 2023. Topics will include school choices, school enrollment, kinder readiness, bus transportation, school age care, and related educational and family supports. There are two sessions available: 0900-1030 & 1530-1700. All sessions will take place in the Training Room in the Main Child Development Center Building, 1085.  - Children must be 5 years of age, by 01 September.
- Purple Star Schools are being launched in Arizona!

- The first candidate school to adopt Purple Star School practices is Luke Elementary School near Luke AFB. Families are encouraged to familiarize themselves with Purple Star Schools and share their stories on the need for military friendly schools as the Arizona legislature considers a bill to establish the program.  - Advertising of these will come from School Liaison.
 - To keep Purple Star status, schools would need to re-apply.
 - Col. Stone endorsed his support. He is hoping to meet with Arizona Governor on this topic.

 - Yuma School District One currently has 5 CYB-MFLCs to provide non-medical counseling support to children who attend covered schools. Resource & Referral

- Hourly and Friday Night Care (FNC)
 - Now available to all on MCAS Yuma
 - Parents must complete a CYP Registration Packet, attend a Parent Orientation and pay a \$35.00 Registration Fee per child. The fee can be carried over, if parent's request and register for Full day or before/after school care.
 - Fees are \$8.00 an hour per child. Reservations can be made two (2) weeks ahead for hourly care, and for FNC reservations can be made one (1) week ahead.
